From the Blood Bank Boys comes a letter: "Dear Father: We want to announce through the Bulletin that the slight mixup last Friday was unavoidable at the time it happened. Thursday 30 fellows failed to keep their appointment. Assuming that about the same number would fail Friday, we over-scheduled on Friday. But on Friday everyone kept his appointment--this caused the surplus and extra waits.

"We are sorry this happened and positively guarantee all that this won't happen again. The Chicago blood bank unit which we have secured will be able to process twice as many an hour. The lines will move more quickly and there won't be any of this waiting around. . . but let everyone keep his appointment.

"This is important! Those who are under twenty-one please bring back your parental permission slips. Hall Chapels Closed.

The rubrics do not permit the use of the hall chapels during the last three days of Holy Week. On Thursday, Friday, and Saturday, the services will be held only in the Main Church. Holy Communion will not be distributed outside of Mass. Note the hours of services. Holy Communion is not distributed at all on Good Friday, except to the dying.

Wednesday of Holy Week, Monday and Tuesday of Easter Week, there will be the regular 7:20 Mass in Dillon chapel. Distribution of Holy Communion till 9 o'clock.

Holy Thursday Mass for employees: the same as last year, at 7 o'clock in Dillon chapel. Permission was granted for this special Mass to accommodate those who have to be at work by 8 o'clock. Holy Communion may be distributed only during Mass.

Holy Week Services: Sacred Heart Church.

Masses: Holy Thursday, 7:00 a.m.
Holy Saturday, 7:30 a.m. (Mass preceded by the blessings--at 6:00 a.m.)

Other Services:

Tenebrae: Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday at 7:30 p.m.

Mass of the Presanctified: Good Friday morning at 8:00.

Way of the Cross: Friday at 3 p.m. It is followed by Benediction with the relic of the True Cross.

Nocturnal Adoration: Watch is kept before the Blessed Sacrament from after the Mass of Holy Thursday until the service Good Friday morning.

Via Matris: for those who are making the Perpetual Novena in honor of Our Mother of Sorrows, the services will be at 5:00 p.m. Good Friday.

Easter Sunday Masses.

There are no student Masses Easter Sunday, but students are expected to attend the parish Masses, which will be at 5 and 6 in the Basement chapel; and at 8, 9, 10, and 11 in the Main Church.
