Even though vacation begins tomorrow, the evening Mass will continue at 5:10 through Wednesday for the faculty, employees, and visitors.

Hall Chapels Will Be Closed

The rubrics do not permit the use of the hall chapels during the last three days of Holy Week. On Thursday, Friday, and Saturday, all services will be held in Sacred Heart Church. Late-Communion Facilities in Dillon, and in Howard, and Cavanaugh, cease tomorrow at noon. On Wednesday morning, there will be Mass for employees in Dillon hall chapel at 7:15. This Mass terminates all services in Dillon until after Easter.

Throughout Easter Week -- daily Mass in Dillon for employees at 7:15.

Holy Week Services - Sacred Heart Church

Holy Thursday -- Solemn Mass at 5 p.m. (Confessions during Mass)
Nocturnal Adoration - Watch is kept before the Blessed Sacrament in
the Lady Chapel from after Mass on Thursday
evening until Services on Good Friday at 3 p.m.
Good Friday -- Services at 3 p.m., with reception of Communion.
Holy Saturday - The Easter Vigil at 8 p.m., with Mass about 9:30 p.m.

Easter Sunday Masses

All Masses on Easter will be celebrated in Sacred Heart Church (5,6,7,8,9,10,11).
After Easter -- daily Mass in Dillon chapel at 7:15 a.m.

Instructions On Communion

The faithful who receive Communion during the afternoon and evening are required to abstain from solid foods for 3 hours -- from liquid foods for 1 hour.

Those who receive Communion on Saturday evening, when the Services take place in the early hours -- as at Notre Dame -- may go to Communion again Easter Sunday.

Those who attend the Easter Vigil Service in the early hours of Saturday evening -- as at Notre Dame -- are obliged to hear Mass on Easter morning.

Those who receive Communion at the Midnight Mass on Saturday evening may not go to Communion again on Sunday, if they attend another Mass on Sunday morning. They have already fulfilled their Sunday obligation, too, by attending the Midnight Vigil Mass.

Holy Saturday: Watch the regulations of your diocese regarding a day of complete abstinence, or partial abstinence (meat at the principal meal only). In the diocese of Fort Wayne, meat is permitted at the principal meal. Lent expires at midnight. Those over 21 - on leaving the campus, are no longer dispensed from fast & abstinence.

Go to Confession Tonight: Travel is hazardous! Sudden death is the order of the day! Don't be half-sure! Avoid the long lines tomorrow. Leave the campus in the state of grace. You never know; you may be next! Go to Confession tonight.
