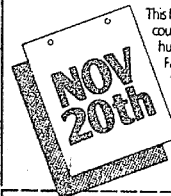

respond to this need.

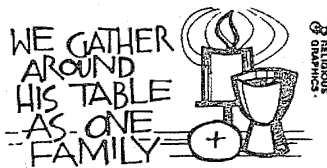
