Practice: Fast or give up your sweets or beer for the day, reflecting on what God has done for us, and give alms, even very small, to the poor.

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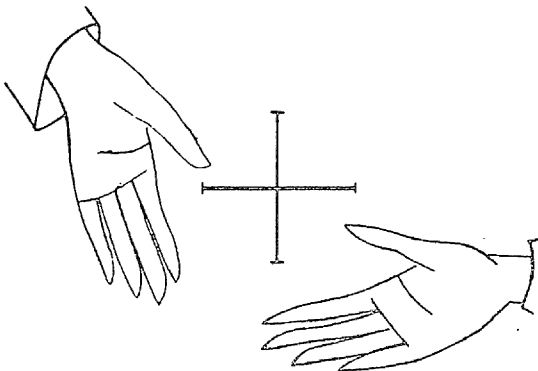
