PRACTICE: Look for the beautiful, and know He wants your Happiness. Today when you sacrifice, love Him first. Think of the beautiful. Thank Him for peace.

SAT MARCH 12: "Bless the Lord, my soul, and remember all his kindnesses, for He pardons all my faults." Ps. 102

PRACTICE: Think of His sacrifice. Know that He loves you first. In the same way, sacrifice for others. Be conscious during the day, of setting self aside. . . feel another's joy, pain, confusion. Feel how Christ does the same for you.
