AMEN.

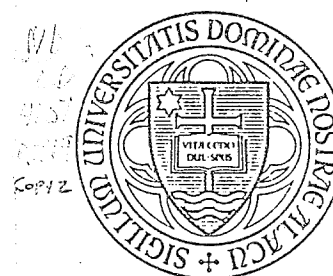
MAY THE BLESSINGS OF THE EARTH--

AMEN.

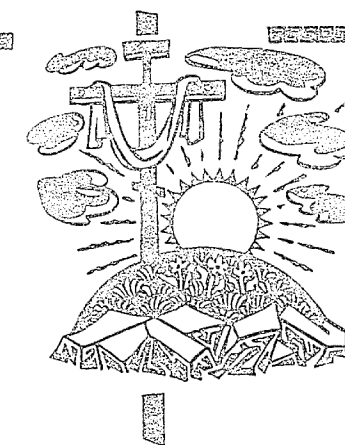

Closing prayer

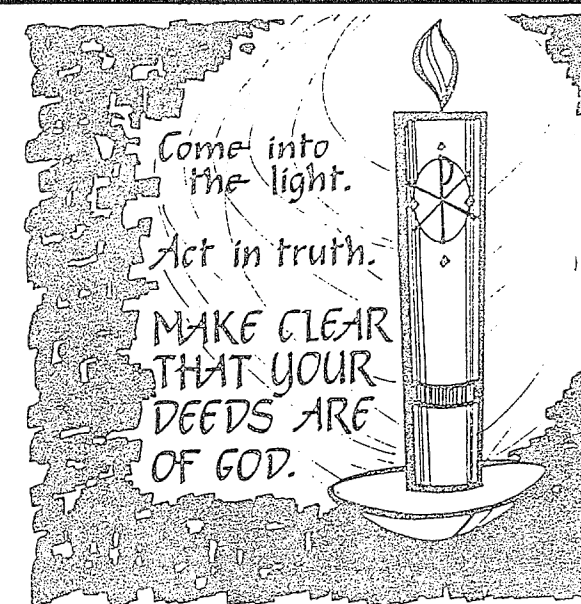
Mary, Queen of Peace,
